Cumberland Attorney is Speaker at Statewide Seminar

Daniel M. It is important that lawyers understand all the tools available at their disposal."

A 1988 *magna cum laude* graduate of Georgetown University Law Center, he was an editor of the Georgetown Law Journal. He received his B.A. from The Johns Hopkins University.
